- **Victor Frankenstein** – *a lost soul looking for meaning and control of that which cannot be controlled, not unkind, but unaware of his effect on others*
- **Baron Alphonse Frankenstein** – *fun-loving, father of Victor, proud and impulsive*
- **William (Willa) Frankenstein** – *curious, kind, generous and trusting younger sibling of Victor*
- **Justine Moritz** – *Gypsy taken in by the Baron and raised as one of the family, now governess to William, grateful, dutiful*
- **Elizabeth Lavenza** – *fiancé of Victor, patient, tortured, open-hearted, ever-hopeful*
- **Henry Clerval** – *best-friend of Victor, privileged, free-spirit but thoughtful, frustrated but confident*
- **Gustav** – *bold and witty rival of Henry, a leader among the other students, a bully who may be correct*
- **The Creature** – *reanimated soul brought to life by Victor, more than a monster, considers himself the son of Victor, desperate for affection, hungry for knowledge, revengeful, never given a name*
- **Waitress** – *full of attitude, familiar and fond of her clientele*
- **Students** – *judgmental and entitled, inexperienced, impulsive*
- **Old Man/Old Woman** – *quirky, lonely, blind, charitable even in their poverty, gentle, book-lover*
- **Grave Digger 1** – *stern, cautious, respectful, dedicated to a fault*
- **Grave Digger 2** – *nervous, opportunistic, ambitious*
- **Countess** – *giddy, flirty, paramour of the Baron, a good dancer*
- **Townspeople** – *excitable, violent, thoughtless*
